**Contract title: Civil works for new construction and interconnecting the existing buildings within the “Pius Brinzeu” Timisoara County Emergency Clinical Hospital in order to reorganize the medical flows for the departments: Emergency, Intensive Care, Surgery and Burn Center**

1. The *Romanian Government* has received a Loan from the World Bank toward the cost of **Health Sector Reform – Improving Health System Quality and Efficiency Project (HSRIHSQEP) implemented through the Project Management Unit**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for **civil works for “Interconnecting the existing buildings and new construction within the “Pius Brinzeu” Timisoara County Emergency Clinical Hospital in order to reorganize the medical flows for the departments: Emergency, Intensive Care, Surgery and Burn Center”**.
2. The *Ministry of Health –Project Management Unit* now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for execution the works required for the investment objective mentioned above, to carry out the following activities simultaneously:
  - i. construction of a new building, to house the diagnostic platforms (within the EAU-SMURD and the radiology-imaging service), as well as the intervention platforms (within the EAU-SMURD, the Operating Ward, the Anesthesia and Intensive Care Units and Burn Center) which currently operate in several hospital buildings, thus improving these medical services that will operate more efficiently by being integrated into a single construction;
  - ii. connecting the new construction with the existing buildings, thus interconnecting the existing buildings with each other, through a walkway system.

The construction of a new building, with height regime U+G+ 4F + 5Fth + Heliport includes the following departments and medical sections:

- EAU-SMURD with 58 positions;
- Burn Center, with 6 boxes for severe burn victims, 6 reserves for intermediate and post-critical burn victims and 5 beds for microsurgery and reconstructive surgery;
- AICU with 27 posts;
- Operating theatre with 25 Operating rooms;
- Related spaces (Sterilization, Pharmacy, administrative and logistical areas, technical areas, etc.)
- Heliport.

The proposed works will be executed within the «Pius Brânzeu» County Emergency Clinical Hospital Timișoara, cadastral no. 448544, str. Bulevardul Liviu Rebreanu no. 156, Timișoara, Timiș County. The period of the contract execution is 26 months.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank’s [\*Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting\*](#)

[Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers](#), January 2011 (“Procurement Guidelines”), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. 5. Site visits conducted by the Ministry of Health through Project Management Unit will be organized on February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022 conditioned by the pandemic evolution, based on the requests sent by potential bidders.

A complete set of bidding documents in English may be obtained by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application that will include the contact details of the company (name, address, telephone no, fax no, e-mail and the name of the responsible person that will receive the bidding documents) to the address below. The bidding documents will be delivered electronically to the prospective bidders representatives.
7. A Pre-Bid meeting will be organized on February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022. This meeting will be held virtually, through a video conferencing platform.
8. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before: *March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 14:00 PM, local time*. Electronic bidding will **not be permitted**. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address below on *March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 14:10 PM, local time*.
9. All bids must be accompanied by a *Bid Security* in amount of *EUR 1,000,000 (one million EUR) or RON 5,000,000 (five million lei)*.
