Recaș Winery, located in Timiș County, boasts a rich and storied history that dates back to the year 1447. The first recorded mention of the Recaş vineyards comes from a notarized document, now preserved in the Banat Museum's treasure, which confirms the official recognition of the Recaş Estates in written sources. This document reveals that Mihail de Ciorna, Ban of Severin, purchased the vineyards from noblemen Ioan and Ecaterina Magyar for 32 florins, a valuable Hungarian gold currency of the time.

The development of the vineyards in Recaş over the centuries has become a significant part of the local culture, transforming into a symbol of the Banat region. Historically, wine from the Recaş vineyards was not just a local product; it served as a form of currency, facilitating trade between East and West. This unique role highlights the importance of Recaş wine in regional commerce and its deep integration into the social and economic fabric of the area.

Throughout history, the ownership of the Recaş vineyards shifted between Hungarians, Austrians, Serbs, Swabians, Croats, and Romanians. Each group, understanding and appreciating the vineyards' value, nurtured them with great care and expertise, leaving their mark on the region's winemaking tradition.

BRIDGING THE PAST AND FUTURE

A pivotal moment in the modern history of Recaş came in 1991 with the establishment of the company Recaş Winery. The company was founded with the mission to carry forward the centuries-old tradition of winemaking while also embracing innovation and modernization. Significant investments, combined with a deep passion for viticulture, have propelled Recaş to the forefront of Romanian wine production.

Today, Recaş Winery is a Romanian-British partnership, cultivating approximately 1,200 hectares of vineyards in the Recaş area. The company leads the Romanian wine industry, not only as the top producer by revenue but also as the largest exporter of bottled wine from Romania. This success reflects the company's dedication to quality, tradition, and innovation, ensuring that the heritage of Recaş wines continues to thrive in the global market.
